A racing dinghy shall carry a rope for towing purposes (this shall be additional safety equipment item; using an existing rope e.g. a genoa sheet is not acceptable)
We can only organise racing with the help of volunteers. Everyone who races is expected to crew the safety/committee boat at least once per series. A roster will be circulated. Please indicate your preferred dates to Captain Dinghies or Captain Adult Sailing.
To be a helm of a club boat you are required to be signed off as competent by a committee member. Please contact Captain Dinghies or Captain Adult Sailing.

You are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and you accept responsibility for exposing yourself to such inherent risk whilst taking part in adult & dinghy sailing sessions.

You must comply at all times with the instructions of the session leader particularly with regard to instructions for boarding and leaving the dinghy, using the equipment on the dinghy and handling sails, wearing of buoyancy aids, and the wearing of suitable clothing in particular footwear for the conditions.

You accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by your own negligence.

You will not participate in the adult sailing & dinghy sessions if your ability to participate is impaired by alcohol, drugs or if you are otherwise unfit to participate.

You will inform the session leader if there have been any changes to the information provided on this form.

You understand that Adult Sailing Sessions are intended to give participants a chance to experience dinghy sailing. You will be under the guidance of a member of the club who has been assessed by Captain Adult Sailing/Captain Dinghies as competent and sufficiently experienced to instruct and teach you. These members may not be qualified instructors.
