

HRSC Dinghy Race Results Sunday 11th August

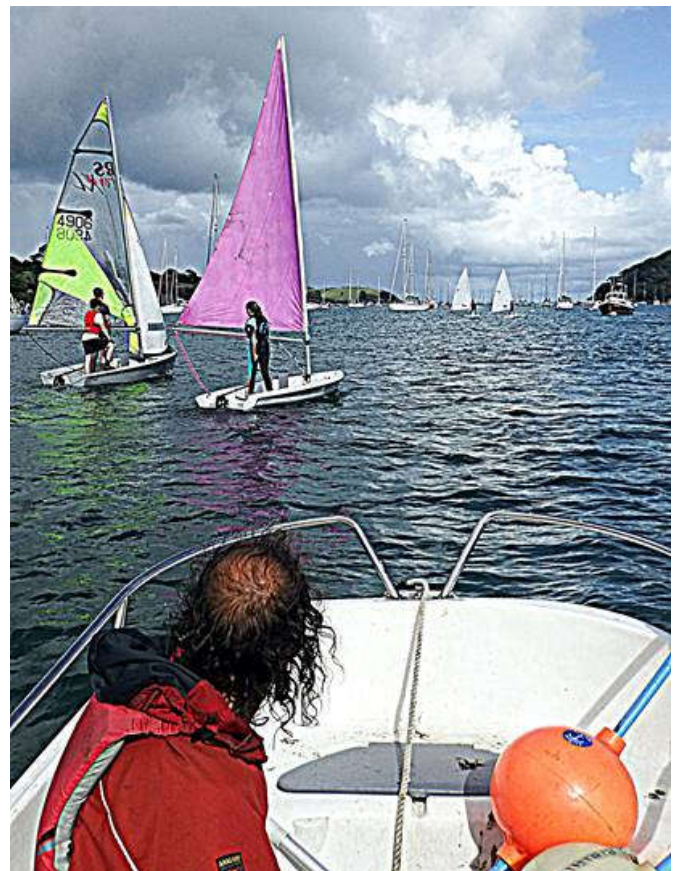
