Unsuccessful applicants will be informed before the 22nd April (however we endeavour to accommodate everyone as far as practicable.)

Following the delayed start last year and risk of further interruptions this year we ask that payment is made when sailing starts, this will £15, and can be paid via cheque to 'HRSC'. We hope to run as many sessions as we can whilst keeping everyone as safe as possible, therefore sailing might take a different format this year once again.

Helping Out

We ask that all parents/guardians are available to help at the beginning and end of the sailing sessions to assist with rigging and de-rigging, and for the wash up and scrub down at the beginning and end of the season. We are particularly keen to hear if you have any instructor qualifications or are interested in getting these, or would like to assist the shore safety team.

Expected Behaviour Contract

While learning to sail can build character, responsibility, discipline, and an appreciation of the outdoors it is also important that we respect the facilities and equipment that are available to us. Therefore we have created a learning contract for each junior to sign, those signing agree to:

- Practice personal and team safety, both ashore and on the water (*ie no jumping off boats unless it is part of a training drill or instructed to do so by a supervising adult*)
- Give my best effort and be ready to be actively involved in the evening's activities with a positive attitude
- Treat instructors, HRSC staff, and fellow teammates with politeness and respect
- Bring all necessary weather appropriate gear, including a lifejacket, wetsuit, wet boots and swimmers
- Stay with my instructor, either on shore or on the water, until given permission to leave by a member of the sailing staff

- Accept and follow the directions and assistance of the sailing instructors
- Respect and help to maintain boats and equipment
- Keep the sailing club bar/restaurant/balcony areas, shower rooms, hallways and training/children's room tidy and as dry as possible (*mop and bucket always available*)

Possible Consequences

- *First Breach:* Sailor receives a warning from the instructor and the incident is documented by the club
- *Second Breach:* Parents receive a phone call home from either the Sailing Captain or Committee member to discuss the problem and arrange a plan of improvement
- *Third Breach:* Parents will be asked to remove their sailor from the program for the duration of the summer (with no refund) and their place taken by the next junior sailor on the club waiting list
