NOTES RELATING TO PROPOSAL FOR MEMBERSHIP

1. Membership Categories

2. Entrance Fee and Annual Subscription

The current year's entrance fee and subscription are published in the Yearbook and details are available on application from the Club office.

3. Payment of Fees and Subscriptions

It is a Club Rule and therefore a condition of membership that fees and subscriptions shall be paid only by Direct Debit from Members' bank or building society accounts. No cash or cheques should be sent with your proposal for membership.

Under Club Rule 16d it is possible to apply to the Treasurer in writing to pay by cheque rather than by Direct Debit to facilitate those applicants with no UK bank accounts. This normally applies to applicants from abroad.

4. Election Procedure

- (a) Your completed form including the Direct Debit instructions to your bank or building society shall be forwarded to the Club Administrator in the Club office. Please retain the tear off guarantee slip.
- (b) The front page only of the form will be displayed in the clubhouse for a minimum period of 7 days and then considered at the next General Committee Meeting.
- (c) If your proposal is accepted you will be informed by the Club Administrator and sent your membership documentation.
- (d) At the same time your Direct Debit instructions will be forwarded to your bank or building society requesting payment of your entrance fee and annual subscription.

Please note: If your application is approved after the 30th September the annual subscription fee is waived for the remainder of that year. The entrance fee will still be collected.

5. Annual Subscription Renewal

Members' bank and building society accounts are automatically debited on the 1st January each year by the new subscription amount(s) as notified by the 20th December in the Club Newsletter. If Members' account details change please send amendments to the Club Administrator immediately.

6. Data Protection

Details given on your proposal will not be used for any purpose other than dealing with your proposed membership of the HRSC. Your personal details will be held on our computer system until such time as we receive a request in writing to cancel your membership. This also applies to Direct Debit information.

FACILITIES

The Clubhouse is situated on the attractive Helford River on the edge of Helford village. Members using the Clubhouse will be met with a warm welcome from our Club Stewards. A varied bar and restaurant menu is available and the bar is stocked with a large selection of alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages. For those requiring them we have laundry facilities comprising washing machine and tumble dryer. We also have shower rooms for those who would like to refresh themselves after a day's sailing. The Club offers various events and lessons for those who wish to become more involved in the sailing activities of the Club.

DINGHIES

The Club has its own dinghy fleet which comprises Wayfarers, Toppers, Fevas and Optimists, all of which are available for use during Club dinghy evenings which are currently Tuesday and Thursday evenings. However the Club dinghies are only available when there is a Safety Boat in attendance and with the approval of Captain Dinghies.

KEELBOATS

The Club offers a full and varied programme of sailing races and events during the season which all Members are invited to join in.

LESSONS

These are available to our junior Members on a Friday evening and to adult Members on a Tuesday evening throughout the summer. All lessons are supervised by volunteer Members who act as instructors.

The Club is now a recognised RYA training centre for under 16's. Other RYA courses including Power Boat Levels 1 & 2, VHF Radio and First Aid are run when numbers permit.

DINGHY PARK, PONTOON & DINGHY RACK

The Club has these facilities available. However, membership of the Club does not give any Member automatic right to the use of any of these facilities. We run a waiting list system, which is strictly adhered to. We cannot therefore guarantee any Member a space as the waiting lists and average waiting time for certain facilities are very long. Fees for these facilities are not included in the membership fee and are payable before any vessel is placed on the property.

CLUB CAR PARK

We are fortunate to be able to offer Members a private car park for their use. However, at certain times during the year, it becomes somewhat congested. On these occasions it is necessary for Members to use the adjacent public car park for which there is a small pay and display charge. We also have many social evenings and various events held throughout the year. We hope that this brief outline gives you the information you require.
