## NOTES RELATING TO PROPOSAL FOR MEMBERSHIP

### 1. Membership Categories

Adult Single Member	(over 18)
Adult Joint Member	(both over 18)

### 2. Payment of Fees and Subscriptions

It is a Club Rule and therefore a condition of membership that fees and subscriptions shall be paid only by Direct Debit from Members' bank or building society accounts. No cash or cheques should be sent with your proposal for membership.

Under Club Rule 16d it is possible to apply to the Treasurer in writing to pay by cheque rather than by Direct Debit to facilitate those applicants with no UK bank accounts. This normally applies to applicants from abroad.

### 3. Election Procedure

(a) Your completed form including the Direct Debit instructions to your bank or building society shall be forwarded to the Club Administrator in the Club office. Please retain the tear off guarantee slip.

(b) If your proposal is accepted you will be informed by email by the Club Administrator and sent your membership documentation.

(c) At the same time your Direct Debit instructions will be forwarded to your bank or building society requesting payment of your annual subscription.

Please note: If your application is approved after the 30th September the annual subscription fee is waived for the remainder of that year.

### 4. Annual Subscription Renewal

Members' bank and building society accounts are automatically debited on the 1st January each year by the new subscription amount(s) as notified by the 20th December in the Club Newsletter. If Members' account details change please send amendments to the Club Administrator immediately.

### 5. Data Protection

### FACILITIES

The Clubhouse is situated on the attractive Helford River on the edge of Helford village. Members using the Clubhouse will be met with a warm welcome from our HRSC Team. A varied bar and restaurant menu is available, and the bar is stocked with a large selection of alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages. For those requiring them we have laundry facilities comprising washing machine and tumble dryer. We also have shower rooms for those who would like to refresh themselves after a day's sailing.

### DINGHIES

The Club has its own dinghy fleet which includes Wayfarers, RS Fevas, RS Visions, Fusions, Lasers, Picos and Optibats. These are available for Club dinghy sessions which are held on Tuesday evenings (adults) and Friday evenings (juniors). Club dinghies are also available for Dinghy Racing on Thursdays and Sundays to Members who have been approved by Captain Adult Sailing, Captain Dinghies or Rear Commodore Sailing. Wayfarers are available at all other times to Members with the above approval via our WhatsApp group. Strict booking out and safety rules must be adhered to. All adults using club dinghies are required to pay an extra annual fee of £25.

### KEELBOATS

Keelboat racing takes place on Wednesday evenings during the season. Members are invited to join in and crew in participating boats. The annual L'Aberwrach race takes place in June.

### JUNIOR SAILING LESSONS

We run a series of sailing lessons every Friday evening from May to September to juniors aged 8-16. We invite applications at the beginning of each year and run a waiting list due to the popularity of the sessions. Please contact our Captain of Juniors if your child is interested in signing up.

### RYA COURSES

The Club is a recognised RYA training centre. RYA Sailing Course are available to juniors. Other RYA courses including Power Boat Levels 1 & 2, VHF Radio and First Aid are run when numbers permit.

### ADULT SAILING


Adult sailing sessions are available to Members on Tuesday evenings and occasionally on Saturdays throughout the summer. Newcomers to sailing are teamed with experienced helms who share basic boat handling skills in one of the club Wayfarer dinghies.

### PONTOON, DINGHY PARK, DINGHY, KAYAK, PADDLEBOARD & CANOE RACK


We want to make sure everyone has a fair chance to enjoy our facilities, so we operate a waiting list system that we strictly follow. So please be aware that we cannot always guarantee to accommodate everyone. In particular there is presently a long waiting list for finger berths. There are separate fees for all these facilities, which are not included in the membership fee. These fees need to be paid before any vessel can be placed on the property.

### CLUB CAR PARK

We are fortunate to be able to offer Members a private car park for their use. Please display your car park sticker. At certain times during the year the club car park becomes somewhat congested. On these occasions it is necessary for Members to use the adjacent public car park for which there is a small charge.
